

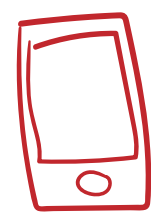

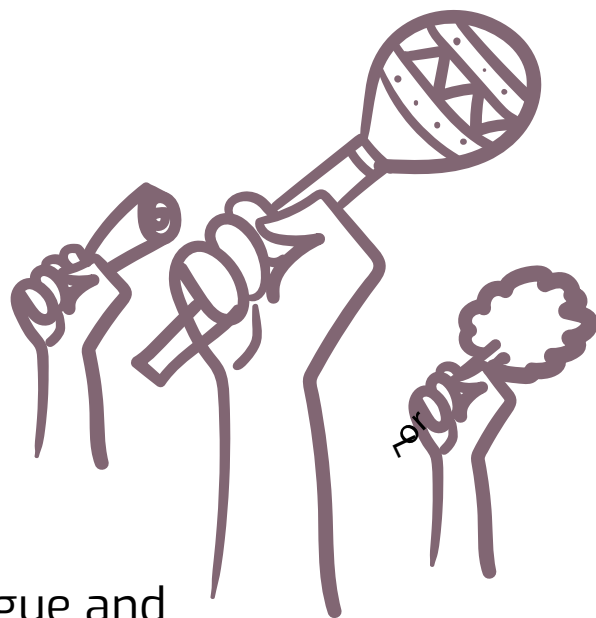


The youth want to find harmony between their ancestry and the non-indigenous world

## COLLABORATION

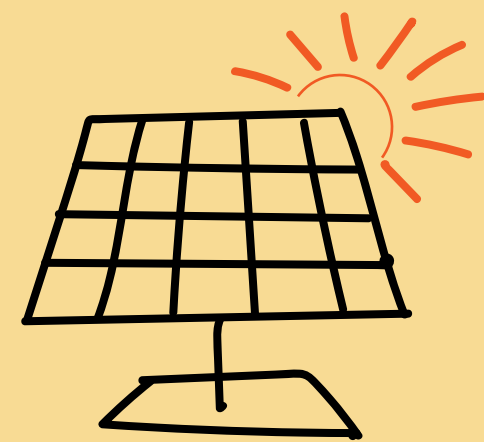

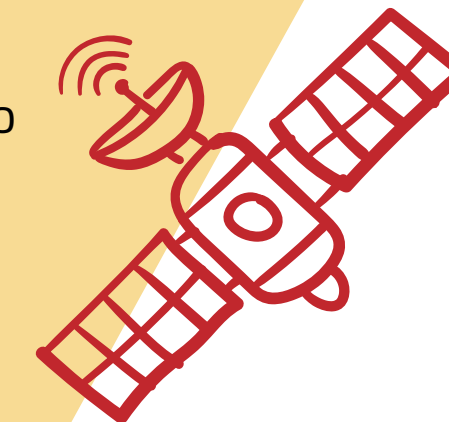
