


Responsibility of allies and donors to support strategic actions of indigenous peoples

The world has many problems and donors change focus




After 5/10 years they change priorities

Affects long-term sustainability of recipients (NGOs/communities) who must keep looking for new donors





We need a greater political vision


INTEGRATING TWO WORLDS


NGOs today work on multiple aspects of the socio-environmental challenge to address different problems at the same time
