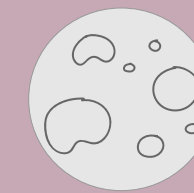

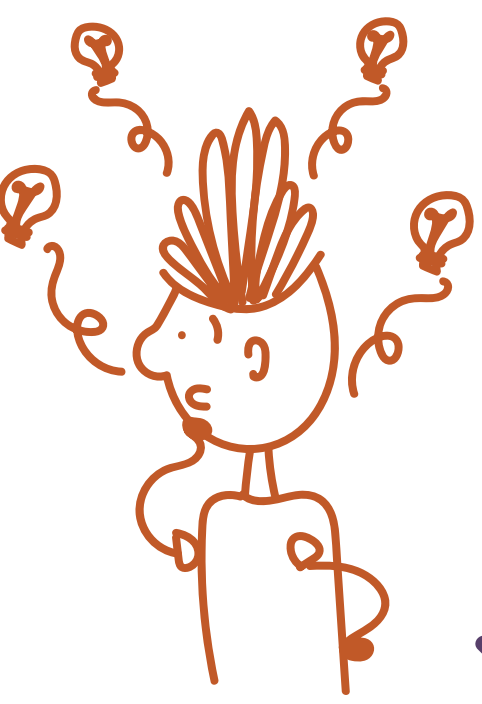
Positive example: Research carried out by UNIR with communities affected by dams in the Madeira River.

Be attentive to the difficulty of local and community participation in hearings held virtually

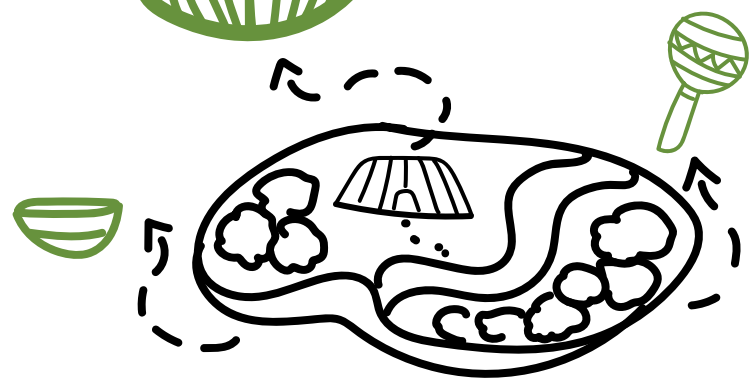

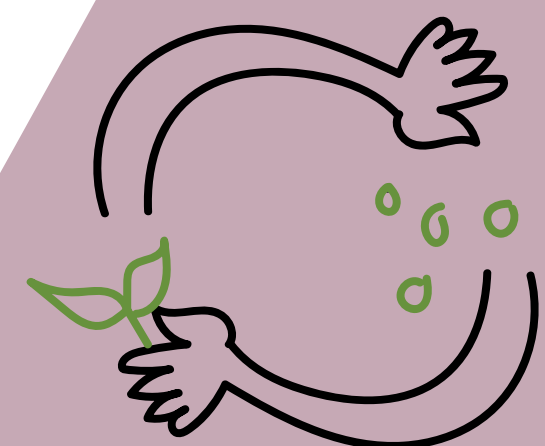
